At the beginning of this year 2007, once again, Representative Frank Acciavatti, of Eastpointe, is sponsoring a Bill (Bill #4429) the "Manufactured Homeowners Bill of Rights." This Bill would help protect homeowners living in these communities throughout Michigan from unscrupulous managers/owners.

Year after year, after elections, we wait hopefully for our new Legislators to pass laws that will protect residents living in Manufactured Housing Communities. Daily you can check the computer and will find meetings of the House of Representative for everything imaginable but you will not find meetings with Legislators to discuss and pass a Bill of rights that gives us rights as American citizens.

We are requesting, as a Representative, you encourage **HOUSE MEMBERS** to come up with a compatible Bill that will give homeowners, in Manufactured Housing Communities, civil rights and liberties they are denied. There are many practices and abuse that are going on in these communities and the elderly are the most vulnerable. Some of the abuses are verbal abuse, evictions without legal cause, intimidation and threats.
