Dear Mr. Wildman:

Thank you for taking the time to contact me in support of the proposed Manufactured Homeowner's Residency Act.

As you know, the so-called Manufactured Homeowners' Bill of Rights did not come up for a vote in the Senate during last year's session, effectively killing the bill. I supported the concept of establishing a "Bill of Rights" for manufactured homeowners last year, but I never received a chance to vote on the legislation. Similar legislation has been reintroduced this session in the House of Representatives. House Bill 4459 includes nearly all of the items that your association included on its written request for re-introduction of the legislation and it avoids much of the additional language that hampered the previous bills. While these bills must still go through the legislative process, I am hopeful that the Senate will be given a chance to vote on this legislation. That being said, I would invite you to review the bill and offer your thoughts for further consideration as the bill comes up for debate.
